

Reconduction of the Progressive Learning Ability Test (PLAT) for the students who missed the PLAT test on 20th December 2025

Participating in the PROGRESSIVE LEARNING ABILITY TEST (PLAT) is compulsory for all students under the NEP every semester.

For students who missed it on December 20, 2025, the PLAT test will be re-conducted as per the earlier PLAT notice.

Students who missed the PLAT are required to pay Rs. 300/- fine to the treasurer's office and carry the receipt to the venue of the PLAT.

The retest is scheduled on Saturday, 10th January 2026, from 2:00 PM to 3:00 PM as per the earlier PLAT notice.

This re-test is compulsory for students who missed the earlier test. Failing to attempt this test will result in the mark sheets for the previous semester (Semester 1/3/5/7/9) being withheld until the test is attempted during the CIA2 week in February 2026, after paying a fine of Rs. 400/-.

The venue for the re-test on 10th January 2026 is LR12, LR43, LR32, LR01, Chemistry Ground floor Laboratory and LR02.
