- All SY & TY BA, SY & TY BSc, SY & TY BSc (IT), SY & TY BAF, SY & TY BAMCJ, and SY & TY BCom with MS students are required to take this test compulsorily.
- ALL MSc Part 2 Students and MA Psychology Part 2 students are required to take this test compulsorily.
- Failing to attempt the test will attract a fine of Rs. 200/-, and the student's marksheet will be withheld till the PLAT is re-attempted either in college or at the office site of the PLAT administrator as per the situation.
